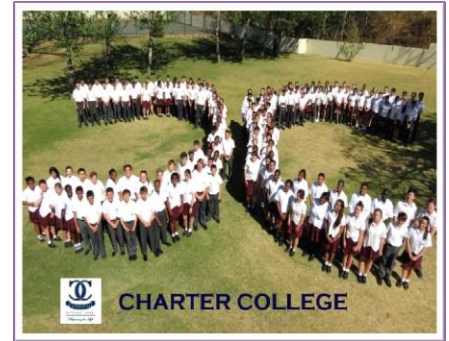
Everyone who was at the event helped make it the great success it was. Thank you for all your support. We are hoping to make this event a tradition at our school.
