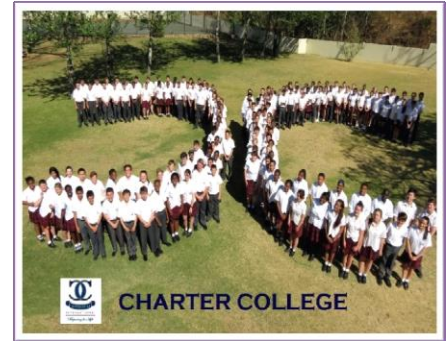

College Exams

Grade 8, 9 and 10 students will start writing their exams on the 14th June. The students will be given the 13th June off school as a study day. This will include the Grade 12 students, as they have two cycle tests that week.

The Grade 11 and 12 students will continue with lessons while the other students are writing their exams.

During the exams:

- All students need to be at school by 07h40.
- All students should be in their full winter uniform.
- Students need to supply their own stationery, which must be in a clear plastic pencil case or Ziploc bag. Stationery includes calculators, protractors and coloured pencils where necessary.
- A water bottle, with water in it, may be brought into the exam room.
- Students may be collected after their last exam each day.
- If your child is not writing an exam on a specific day, they are not required to be at school.
- Students should eat breakfast before coming in to write an exam.
- Lots of love and support is always needed.
