CAMBRIDGE NEWS

The Cambridge exam timetable for the May/June Examinations can be found on the D6 under resources. The I.G.C.S.E. students have all been given a copy of the timetable. All students writing the May/June exams will be given a statement of entry this week. This must be checked thoroughly and signed. If there are errors on the statement of entries, Cambridge charges for corrections that need to be made.

CONCESSIONS

A few students may need to apply concessions for cycle tests and exams. Should a student battle to read, have dyslexia, dyspraxia, have hand writing that is difficult to read, a sight or hearing problem they may be eligible for concessions. Should your child need any concessions a psychologists, or other professional report must be provided to the school. Cambridge may or may not grant concessions. Concession reports may not be older than 3 years.
