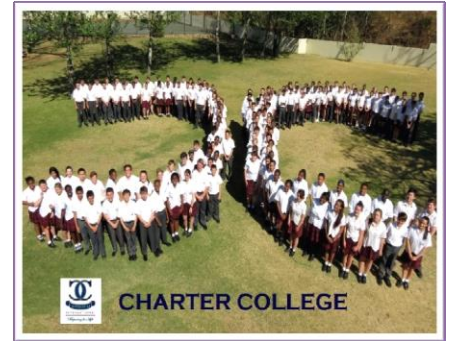

FIRST AID COURSE

As part of our NEW values program the grade 11's took part in a First AID/CPR course.

The course included initial intervention in a serious condition prior to professional medical help being available, such as performing CPR while awaiting an ambulance, as well as the complete treatment of minor conditions, such as applying a plaster to a cut.

Our children learnt the about: C-A-B (Compressions-Airway-Breathing) and the basics involving specific training or equipment such as a Defibrillator
