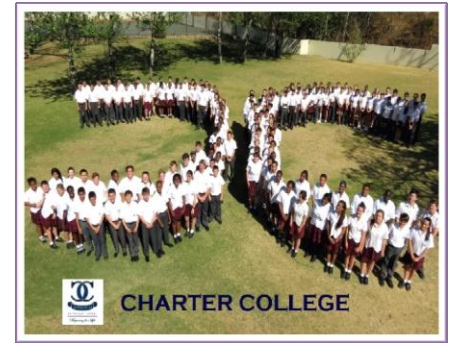

Building and Road Works

This is almost complete. Thank you to Gawie, Cornay and the team from Triple 3 Construction.

As you have all seen, many of our new road signage has been put up. Please can we work together to make sure that the signage is adhered to this is for the safety of all concerned, especially our students.

- We would like the road to be used as a one way between 06:30 & 08:00 and 14H00 AND 15H00 (MONDAY –FRIDAY)
- Any Parent driving into the school must park over the bridge during the above times.
- Once you enter the school grounds the road needs to be treated as a one way. I.e. do not come back out the main gate.
- No one may use the parking next to McKendry Hall as a drop off.
- Students who are dropped off in the school grounds must make use of the pedestrian walk way if necessary.
- Pupils dropped off outside the school ground may ONLY use the pedestrian Gate. NO STUDENT will be allowed to use the entrance at Mckendry Hall during the morning and afternoon times mentioned above. This is for the safety of our students.
- The parking gate next to the pedestrian gate needs to be kept clear at all times. This parking entrance is for teachers only.
- All students who have cars, or motorbikes, have to hand in a copy of their driver's license at the office. Students with a valid license may park in the designated parking in the school grounds near the exit gate. Any student without a valid driver's license will not have access to the inside parking.
